Design-out Destitution

- Sustaining, expanding and improved signposting to destitution payment / support initiatives
- Tackling barriers to engagement e.g. digital exclusion
- Development / improvement of pathways out of destitution in the long term
- Creating a support system in which destitution does not exist

- Listening to people and gathering stories
- Using stories to inform project and system change
- Individuals with lived experience and frontline workers at the centre of designing what 'good' looks like
- Access to senior politicians – locally and nationally
- Individuals have ownership of their future

Advocating for change nationally

Informed & Supported

- Outreach/training on sources of support & advice
- IAG which addresses individual's needs based on immigration status
- Specific and targeted support e.g. EUSS late applications, employment support
- City wide / regional approaches to tackling immigration advice capacity
